








Three Horizons

Agency

How does the Three Horizons differ from other tools

Roadmaps

Bringing actors together to remove uncertainty and to settle down on a direction of travel and agree to do things in a certain way to determine the future

Forecasting

Where the past is a reasonable guide to the future:
Low complexity and probability has some meaning


Reflective Futures / Three Horizons

Pathways, but acknowledges what we don't know, and based on feedback as we progress, offers the opportunity for course correction and adaptation/evolution

Scenario Planning/Thinking

Lay out possible scenarios to come up with different stories of the unfolding future, informing our thinking. Telling stories and narratives and making plans based on them.

- Bridges present to future




Visionary
